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### **PREPARING FOR SURGERY – Labiaplasty**

Be certain to read these instructions carefully prior to your surgery and follow them closely.

#### **FIVE WEEKS BEFORE SURGERY**

- Discontinue all nicotine products.
- Call the office to schedule your preoperative appointment. During this appointment you will be given your prescriptions and photos will be taken (for out of town patients, this is commonly done over the phone).

#### **THREE WEEKS BEFORE SURGERY**

- Confirm surgery date with our office
- Arrange your transportation for the day of surgery
- Arrange for accommodations if you live outside Portland (plan to stay one night in Portland after surgery)
- Arrange for someone to stay with you the night of surgery
- **FIRST POST-OP APPOINTMENT** will be 1 day after surgery. You will need someone to drive you to this appointment.

#### **TWO WEEKS BEFORE SURGERY**

- You will have your pre-operative appointment 2-3 weeks before surgery.
- Have all prescriptions filled (given at pre-op appointment)
- Do not take any aspirin, ibuprofen (Motrin), Vitamin E, fish oil, garlic supplements, bromelain or medicines containing these compounds for 14 days before your surgery. Other medications prescribed by your personal physician should be taken as necessary.
- Purchase the following over-the-counter medications (**Bacitracin Ointment, Docusate, Tylenol, Senna**)
- Purchase labiaplasty supplies. See link at [www.DrHayesSupplies.com](http://www.DrHayesSupplies.com)
- Purchase maxipads to help absorb drainage from the incisions.
- Payment due for surgery

#### **24 HOURS BEFORE SURGERY**

- Do not shave your pubic region within 2 days of surgery.

- Should you desire, you may trim pubic hair with an electrical clippers the day before surgery.
- Relax and eat well.
- **Do not eat or drink anything.** *including chewing gum and breath mints,* **after midnight prior to your surgery**

### **DAY OF SURGERY**

- Brush your teeth (**do not swallow any water**). Leave contact lenses at home.
- Avoid using hair products, body lotions, deodorants or perfumes on the day of surgery.
- Wear a front-buttoned shirt, comfortable pants and shoes (something that slips on and off easily). Bring a jacket.
- Leave valuables at home, including jewelry, handbags
- **Arrive on time**
- Your caregiver will be instructed in post surgical care when they arrive to transport you.
- Bring all medication that has been prescribed for this procedure with you on the day of surgery.

### **POST OP APPOINTMENTS**

A 1 day post-op and 5-7 day post-op appointments will be scheduled. Please anticipate additional post-op visits at 2 weeks, and 6 weeks. **We do request a minimum of 48 hours** for cancellation or change of appointments.

- **FIRST POST-OP APPOINTMENT** will be 1 day after surgery. You will need someone to drive you to this appointment.
